

# ?Databases



Start by navigating to your servers panel - from the dashboard. Click "Database" in the side view.

Next click "Create" in the top right corner

Name this something appropriate for what you need it for (recommended)

Clicking "View" on the database gives you more information as shown below

After creating your database you should see something like the following:

In the example above,  
"S314\_test" is the database name  
"db.atomichost.xyz" is the host  
"3306" is the port
